



## Doylestown Health System Report

The wonderful holiday season is here! I hope your Thanksgiving celebrations with family and friends was a joy to all of you.

Our Trustee Education for this month was presented by Laura Wortman and included an update of the One Vision Campaign. Jim emphasized the critical role philanthropy plays in providing necessary funding for our excellent health system. All manner of marketing efforts are being utilized, from the work of the campaign committee to mail and media.

The Clinical Quality Report pointed out the improvements in sepsis care. A root cause could not be determined for an earlier spike in surgical site infections in hip replacements after much analysis, although all three cases were high risk. However, measures taken in sterile processes, air flow, and closed doors may be contributing to the better outcomes now being seen. There was an increased use of bed alarms to help prevent falls. Also, families are being included on rounds. Doylestown Health has recently received some outstanding awards such as Top 50 Cardiovascular Hospital, Pine Run Health Center U.S. News Top Rates and Leapfrog "A" grade in Patient Safety.

Although a higher acuity of patient is being seen and admitted at Pine Run, the quality measures keep improving. The Continuity Assessment Record Evaluation, which measures results for Medicare patients, shows a 24% or greater improvement from admission to discharge. Pine Run has also earned 5 Stars from CMS in four of five measures and 4 Stars in the fifth measure.

The financial results show the Pine Run Operating Gain is favorable. There were 503 units occupied, 1.5% above the prior year. DH Physicians is 5.5% favorable to budget. Revenues for ongoing practices increased by 8.5% while expenses increased 5.8%. There is growth for DH Physicians in Cardio-Vascular Thoracic Surgery, Breast Surgery, Urology, Neurology, and Cardiology. Doylestown Hospital's Financial and Statistical Results show a small operating gain. Net patient revenue has increased 2.2% over prior year.

Overall, Total Revenue has increased 2.2% over YTD October 2017. The Unrestricted Net Assets decreased by \$2.6M since June 2018 because of October's market impact to Funded Depreciation and Pension Assets. In August a \$6M draw was made to meet operating cash needs. YTD the Health System shows an operating loss but a favorable variance from last year. Foundation Restricted Net Assets have increased by \$2.1M fiscal year-to-date due to new donations and pledges. All Bond Covenants were met.

The Medical Executive Committee asked for approval for physicians and Advanced Practice Providers for membership privileges or status change contingent on endorsement by the Medical Executive Committee which had not met yet. Three physicians were approved in the Medical Service Line for GI privileges. One Advanced Practice Provider was approved for the Hospitalists. Two physicians were approved for a change in status from Provisional to Active.

Please join us for a presentation about "The Opioid Crisis" by Brenda A. Foley, MD. Dr. Foley serves as the Assistant Medical Director of the



She is on numerous committees at Doylestown Hospital and, most recently, was elected to the position Secretary/Treasurer of the Medical Executive Committee. Dr. Foley initiated the Narcotic Responsible Hospital Policy at Doylestown Hospital and has co-authored a chapter in Clinical Procedures in Emergency Medicine. Dr. Foley received her Bachelor's in Comprehensive Science from Villanova University, her Doctor of Medicine degree from The Medical College of Pennsylvania, and completed her Emergency Medicine residency at Thomas Jefferson University Hospital.

The opioid crisis has had a tremendous impact on the entire country and now is considered the deadliest drug overdose crisis in United States history. Dr. Foley will present a brief overview of the development of this opioid crisis, the latest data on the impact of the crisis on our community, and the current efforts both locally and nationally to combat this devastating epidemic.
