The reverence shown above by President Harry S. Truman for Medal of Honor winners is well deserved. The Medal of Honor is the United States government's highest and most prestigious military decoration that may be awarded to recognize American military heroes who have distinguished themselves by acts of valor under heavy fire. The Medal is normally awarded by the President of the United States in the name of the United States Congress, and the criteria for its receipt is rigorous.

At our November 1 Petite Luncheon, you will learn the history of the Medal of Honor and the stories of amazing individuals who received it. You may be surprised to learn that one recipient was a woman who earned this honor long before you might imagine!
